## Things to do

- Find out about an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander cultural heritage site near to where you live. There may even be sites close to you that are suitable to visit.
- Organise a celebration of Mabo Day (3 June) in your workplace.
- Attend the AIATSIS annual National Native Title Conference in the first week of June around Mabo Day. The conference is held in a different location each year in partnership with the Native Title Representative Body and the traditional owners of the location.
- Go to the annual Garma Festival in the Northern Territory. Garma is hosted, co-ordinated and programed by the Yothu Yindi Foundation.
